






## **The Ten Talents**

Find your way through the maze to the 5 talent bag.





Jesus' stories had more than one meaning. For example, this story is about talents which were large amounts of money in Bible times. Today a talent might be worth a million pounds!


Now we think of talents as our gifts or abilities. Our talents are something special and amazing that God gives to us, almost like a super power.






This Sunday is the Feast day of Saint Zachariah.
