

John chapter 20 verses 1-18

After Jesus died, a man named Joseph (who came from Arimathea) put Jesus in His tomb. The tombs they used then were cut out of rock, almost like a cave, they weren't buried deep in the ground like they are now. He and some men rolled a large heavy stone in front of the tomb. Mary and Mary Magdalene waited a day to see Jesus because they couldn't go on the Sabbath (which was a day of rest). They made spices and oils as a sign of respect to Jesus and went very early Sunday morning.



Now on the first day of the week Mary Magdalene came to the tomb early, while it was still dark and saw that the stone had been taken away from the tomb. She ran and went to Simon Peter and John and said to them "They have taken the Lord out of the tomb and we do not know where they have laid him." So Simon Peter went with John to the tomb. John stooped to look in, saw the linen cloths lying there but he did not go in. Then Simon Peter went into the tomb. He saw the linen cloths lying there and the face cloth which had been on Jesus' head. John went in and was puzzled for as yet they did not understand the Scripture, that he must rise from the dead. Then the disciples went back to their homes.

But Mary Magdalene stood weeping outside the tomb. As she wept she saw two angels in white, sitting where the body of Jesus had lain, one at the head and one at the feet. They said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping?" She said to them, "They have taken away my Lord, and I do not know where they have laid him." Having said this, she turned around and saw a man standing there but she did not know that it was Jesus. Jesus said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping? Whom are you seeking?" Thinking he was the gardener, she said to him, "Sir, if you have carried him away, tell me where you have laid him, and I will take him away." Jesus said to her, "Mary." She turned and said to him "Master." Jesus said to her, "go to my brothers and say to them, 'I am ascending to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God." Mary Magdalene went and announced to the disciples, "I have seen the Lord"—and that he had said these things to her. -John 20:1-18





## The 5 miracles of Easter


Do you know what a miracle is?




### Miracle 1




The biggest miracle of all. Jesus rose from the dead! After 3 whole days of being dead, Jesus was alive again!
